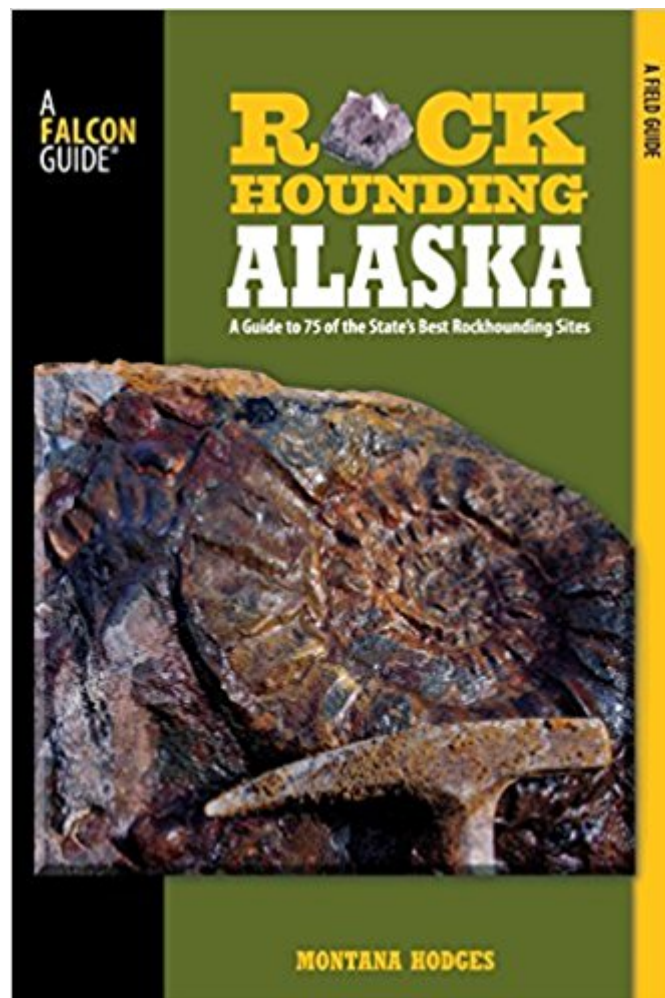




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Rockhounding Alaska: A Guide To 75 Of The State's Best Rockhounding Sites (Rockhounding Series)
