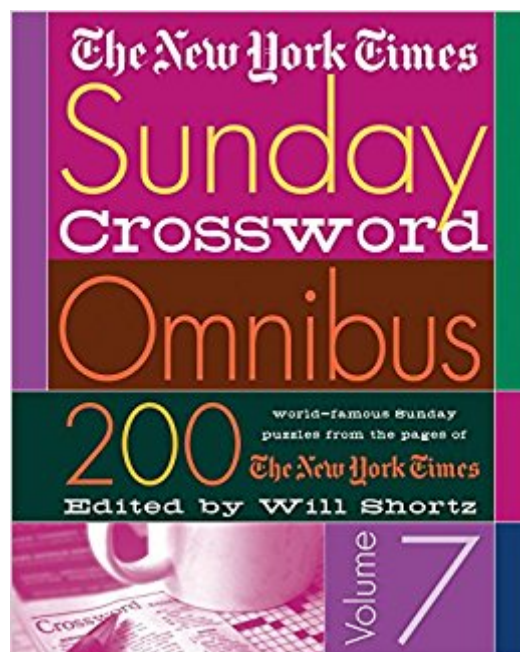

It's great because I can actually see it! Some puzzle books the print is way too small. This one is perfect and will definitely keep your brain sharp.

These crosswords are always challenging and stimulating. Lots of double meanings so you realize the complexities of the English language. I do them with my wife because it often takes the two of us to do them. Course if you're a Jeopardy champion you would not be at all interested.

Exactly what I like. Not easy, medium crosswords but challenging!

The puzzles are fun and absorbing, no question of that. I do take issue, however, with the quality of the paper, which is like newspaper and easily compromised when erasing. If that's not done gingerly, the paper can rip. Others of the '200 Sunday' lot are all-around better constructed.

This is a good puzzle book, with just the right amount of challenge for me. I am enjoying doing these, but I do wish the print could be a bit larger. I don't require, or even want, "large print" puzzles, but I do find these a little bit uncomfortably small. The puzzles do have titles, although at least one reviewer indicated that his copy did not.

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
