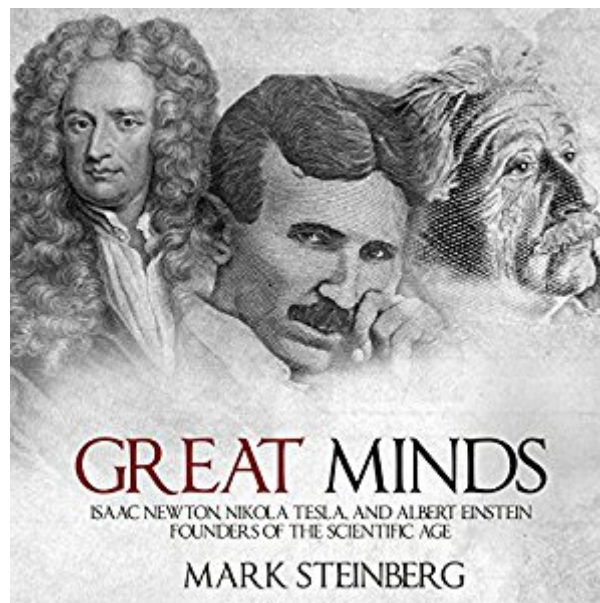


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Great Minds: Isaac Newton, Nikola Tesla, And Albert Einstein, Founders Of The Scientific Age
