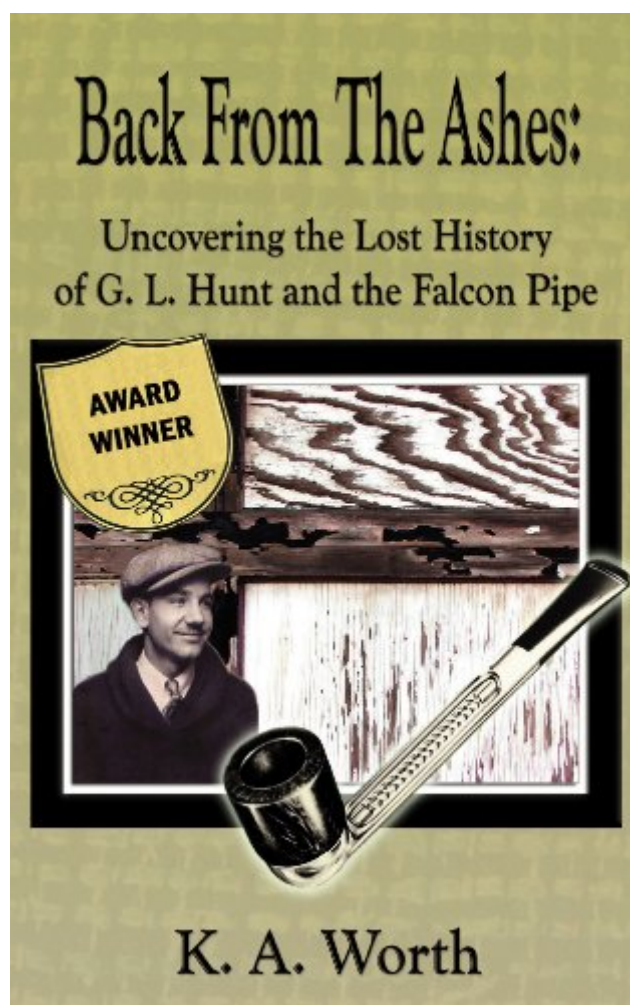

Although written by a non-professional author, this was a good and very interesting read. Highly personal, this treatment gives much background about the history of the folks behind the scenes. I expected the history of the Falcon pipe to be much more interesting than the people behind it (part two versus part one of the book) I was pleasantly surprised to be drawn into both sections with equal interest. For any Falcon fan/collector or pipe man interested in history this will be a good addition to your library.
