Great essay by Thorne. The other pieces in here seem marginal in comparison. Info is repeated throughout as if we didn't just read the same thing in a previous article. Some pieces are truncated to be resumed in another issue. Bad idea. Design, layout, and writing need to be stepped up if they truly want to walk in the Wrapped in Plastic shoes. Great potential here and I hope they can find their voice.

All Twin Peaks fans are excited about the return of their beloved show, coming on May 21, 2017 on Showtime! On Facebook there are innumerable fan pages, discussion and meme groups. There are seemingly hundreds of Twin Peaks-related blogs and podcasts on YouTube and elsewhere online. I often feel overwhelmed with the constant barrage and sheer volume all of the articles, pics, commentaries, previews about Twin Peaks! THE BLUE ROSE is a new magazine which goes a long way toward helping sort it all out! Created by a team of scholars, bloggers, podcasters, artists and designers, and diehard fans of the show, THE BLUE ROSE gives the TP enthusiast an in-depth look at possibilities for the new third season, reports on TP related media (books, recordings, etc.), interviews, and analyses and reactions to the TP phenomenon in 2017. There is a nice balance between scholarly articles and reviews (without being jargon-laden and overly-academic) and personalized reflections and viewpoints. Especially interesting to me are the two articles reviewing Mark Frost's book *The Secret History of Twin Peaks*. TSHoTP is controversial and misunderstood by many Twin Peaks fans, but I love it! John Thorne and Courtenay Stallings offer multiple ways to approach and interpret the book which deepen my appreciation of *The Secret History*. Other highlights include a report on the UK Twin Peaks Festival; an interview with Bob Engels, who wrote nine of the TP episodes and co-wrote *Fire Walk With Me*; plus two articles about the FWWM soundtrack; and a heartfelt tribute to *The Log Lady*, Catherine Coulson. The magazine itself looks great in Kindle format! The photos and artwork are vivid, and the layout is clean and attractive. The formatting is also top-notch. It looks and reads well in both Kindle Cloud Reader and in the Kindle app on my iPhone. Check out the free sample previews of the book.
