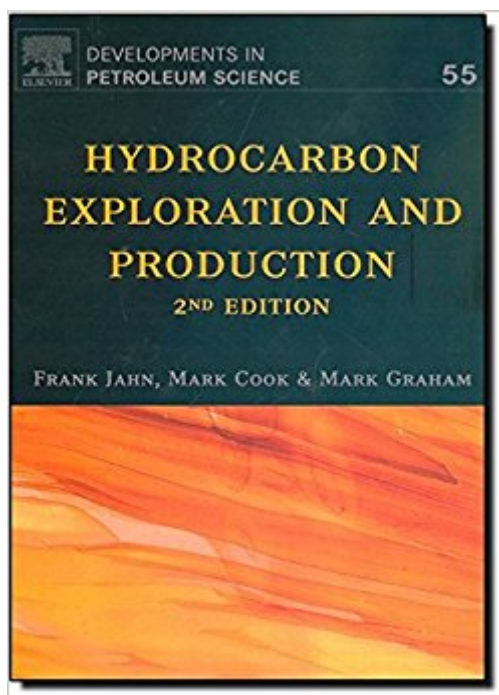


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Hydrocarbon Exploration And Production, Volume 55, Second Edition (Developments In Petroleum Science)
