

The titles included in this box set are;A Sleepover Sleuths (Nancy Drew and the Clue Crew #1),Scream for Ice Cream (Nancy Drew and the Clue Crew #2),Pony Problems (Nancy Drew and the Clue Crew #3),The Cinderella Ballet Mystery (Nancy Drew and the Clue Crew #4), andA Case of the Sneaky Snowman (Nancy Drew and the Clue Crew #5). In each book, Nancy teams up with her best friends, cousins George and Bess, to solve a perplexing mystery. Nancy, Bess, and George are now in third grade and have begun cutting their teeth as sleuths on simple, age appropriate mysteries. I was a huge Nancy Drew fan in my childhood, so it was a little weird for me to read these ND books with computers, cell phones, and other modern day tech. It made the original Nancy Drew books seem positively ancient! LOLTHE SLEEPOVER SLEUTHIn this book

Nancy, Bess, and George are invited to a sleepover at the home of their classmate, Deidre. It's a City Girls doll theme and each guest is asked to bring her own City Girls doll to the sleepover. When Deidre's City Girl doll, Hollywood Hannah, goes missing, Nancy, Bess, and George spring into action to solve the mystery. I read this book with my daughter. Deidre is from a wealthy family, and is a bit of a spoilt brat. It was really interesting following the story as the girls try to piece together all the clues they uncover to figure out the whereabouts of Deidre's doll.

SCREAM FOR ICE CREAM In this story, Nancy, Bess, and George enter a contest hosted by the local ice-cream factory.

Contestants must come up with recipes for brand-new flavors using whatever ingredients they want.

When a friend's secret recipe goes missing, Nancy, Bess, and George get cracking on the

case.

PONY PROBLEMS Mr. Johnson's Shetland pony, Buttons, keeps escaping his pen at the local

petting zoo and is roaming all over town. Mr. Johnson is stumped, because no matter what he does,

Buttons keeps getting away. Nancy, George, and Bess are determined to solve the mystery of the

escaping pony.

THE CINDERELLA BALLET MYSTERY In this story, Nancy, Bess, and George are

going to be in a ballet. Their friend, Andrea, is slated for the part of Cinderella, and as part of her

costume she gets to wear a specially ordered pair of ballet shoes, shipped all the way from France!

Unfortunately, just days before the performance is schedule to occur, the slippers go missing and

there isn't time to order a new pair. Nancy, Bess, and George must solve the mystery of the missing

ballet slippers, and the clock is ticking!

THE CASE OF THE SNEAKY SNOWMAN This was a very

cute story. Deidre transforms herself into a Madame Chocolata, a fortune-teller, and tells Nancy,

Bess, and George that their snowman, Sherlock, will "walk away."

When Sherlock disappears, all

the clues seem to indicate that Deidre's prediction has come true. But can a snowman walk?

Each of the stories included in this box set is well written and includes several nicely illustrated pictures. The

recommended age range is 6-9; Grades 1-4. When my daughter first received this box set for her

7th birthday last summer, my husband and I would take turns reading the books with her. She loved

them so much that she began borrowing other books in the series from the library. Now that she's in

Second Grade, she is able to read the NDCC books independently (FYI she reads at a 4th grade

level.) These books are a winner all around; they are interesting, thought provoking, entertaining,

and are age appropriate. As a parent, I highly recommend them.
