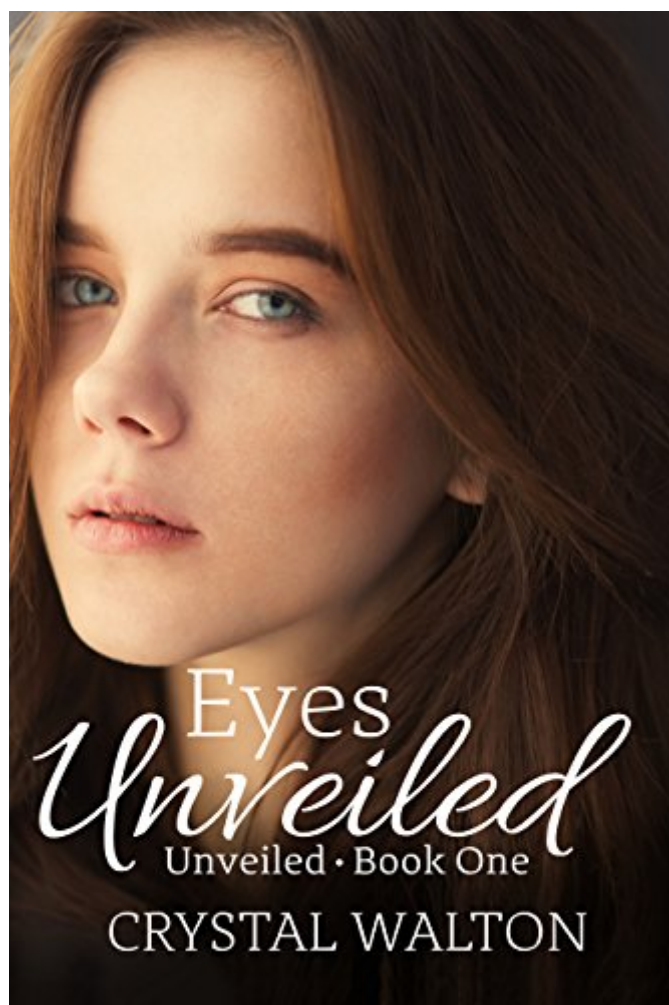

The first time I tried to read this book I could not get into it. It was my fault; I was in a terrible mood and had no wish to read anything involving romance. Because I was in such a bad mood, I knew I wouldn't give this book the chance it deserved. So I put it down for the time being to pick up again later. I am glad I did- the second time I really enjoyed it. While a major focus of the novel is the love story between Emma and Riley, other themes of the novel include friendship, and balancing school work, family, and internships. Emma and Riley have a lot in common. They are both majoring in fields they don't enjoy, they both play guitar, and they both are fascinated with each other. Often Emma tries to please everyone around her, even when it makes her unhappy. Riley won't go for his dream because he is afraid he will become someone he doesn't want to be. It was fascinating to watch how Emma and Riley can see each other's gifts, talents and worth, but not see their own. Crystal Walton's novel encourages her readers to go for their dreams, even when it's not easy. She also points out that sometimes you just need someone who believes in you, especially when you no longer believe in yourself. A perfect summer read so go check it out.
