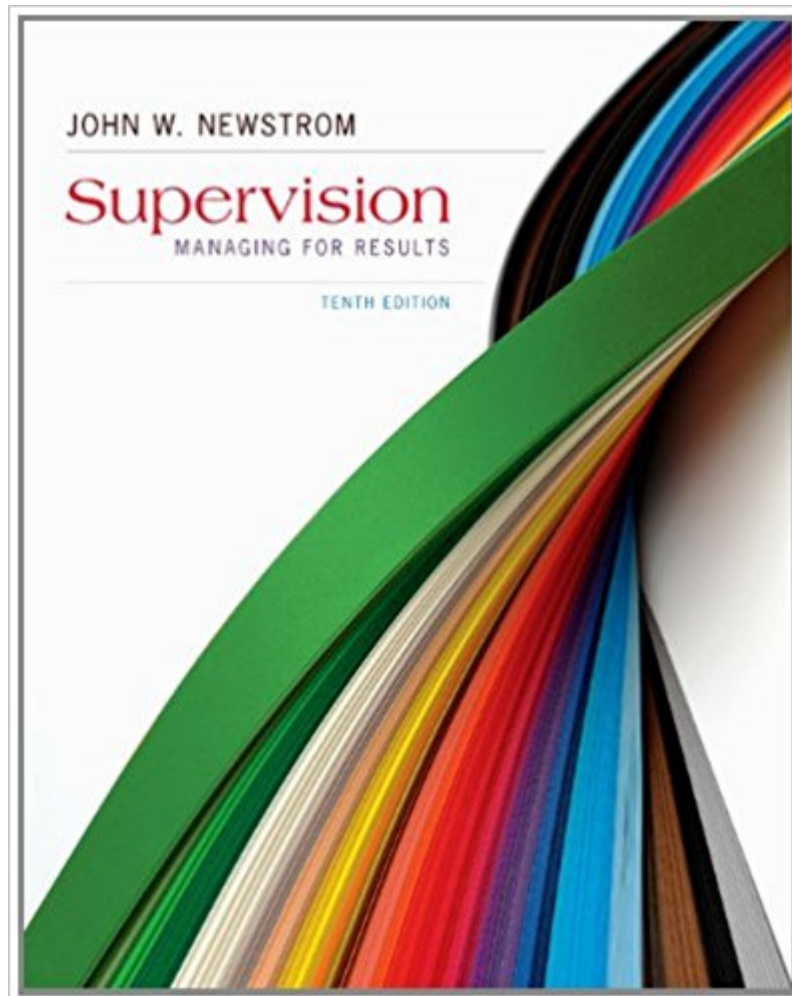




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Supervision: Managing For Results

The book is easy to read and understand, and presents information in a pretty clear format. It gives a few different ways to measure progress through the book, from pre- and post- chapter quizzes, to common question and answers and activities. As far as the meat of it goes, most of the content isn't going to come as a shock to anyone who's ever been a leader or

supervisor in the past. A lot of it is common knowledge or practice, but I found that it was kind of helpful for me to actually see a number of common practices put in to words. It's a good way to understand employee motivations, and better understand your own style and role in leadership positions. It's probably written most with the concept of production work in mind, factories or call centers maybe, but many of the lessons are applicable in a much broader range of fields (ours specifically being construction). This version is up to date enough to have taken the role that social media now plays in employee interaction and communication in to account as well. Overall, no real complaints here.
