

A new section on monitoring equipment and principles includes information on proper setup and use of monitoring equipment, and limitations of equipment. Incorporates the latest pediatric drug information. Covers conscious/deep IV sedation in the PICU. Includes HIPPA regulations for bedside nursing care. Updated case studies in the Appendix section feature accompanying questions and answers for review.
