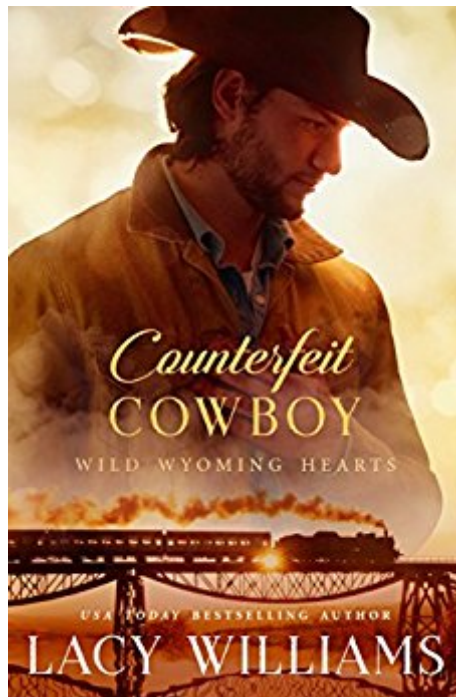

Jesse, a thief, conman, recently out of prison meets Erin a wealthy kind hearted, compassionate young lady. From two different worlds...could love be any further apart...when it comes to the heart, only God knows.

The Counterfeit Cowboy is a charming tale of a man fresh out of prison and a naive but kind-hearted woman fleeing her restrictive father. Jesse wants to change his ways but he's a man of no means. Erin takes him and his brother under her wing on her trip west to visit her brother. Friendship blossoms as do sparks of romance, but will the secret he's keeping drive a wedge between him and Erin? Lacy Williams has penned another intriguing western that kept me riveted to the pages. I didn't want to put the book down to tend to things that needed my attention. Her writing just keeps getting better and better.

Sweet story of two people, a boy and a man, trying to redeem themselves when they encounter a young woman who embodies love for her fellow people. In the process, she transforms her male companions. I will say that I was disappointed near the end by the heroine's confusion and anger which caused the story to lose its momentum. It allowed for the completion of the hero's redemption, but it forced a rushed and somewhat unbelievable ending. I always enjoy Lacy Williams's novels for their unusual characters and plot lines.

The story is a beautiful demonstration of how God uses the power of love and compassion to turn lives around. It is heartwarming to feel the emotions of the characters as these changes are taking place in their hearts.

I found this book okay, but not her best work. It is slow and frankly needed more of a change in settings. I found the heroine a bit too sweet, but the boy was precious. I recommend other books by this author instead.

This was a light read, but enjoyable. The message of a changed life through Jesus Christ was

encouraging. The story was a bit predictable, yet had some turns which kept you entertained.
