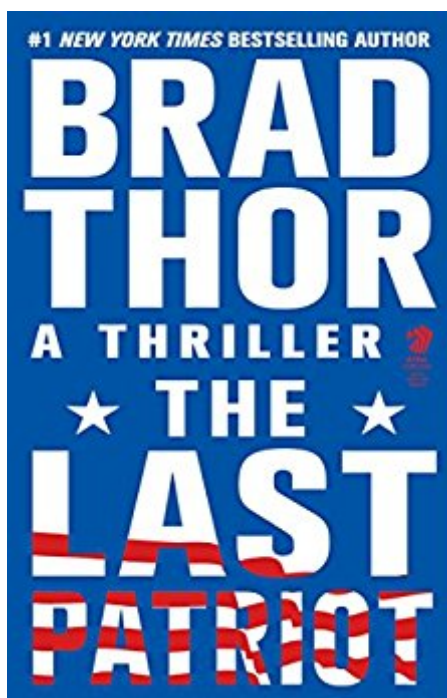


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The Last Patriot: A Thriller (The Scot Harvath Series Book 7)

It might be me, but the conclusion of the book ended rather hastily as if Brad had to meet a deadline and rushed the ending. I enjoyed the Thomas Jefferson history woven into the thriller, but thought Brad Thor would have developed a more detailed confrontation between Dodd and Harvath.

I learned something about Thomas Jefferson that I didn't know before. Jefferson was afraid of what would happen if Islam got a good hold and what might happen in this country if it did. I even checked some of the facts as presented in the book and they were right. The storyline warns us about the hardliners of Islam and how they can insinuate themselves into our culture. Interesting how religious history would have changed if the events in this book had panned out.

Brad Thor continues to educate on relevant subjects while creating his fast action style of fiction. Book 7 continues his string of well thought out story lines and fictional characters to support his themes.
