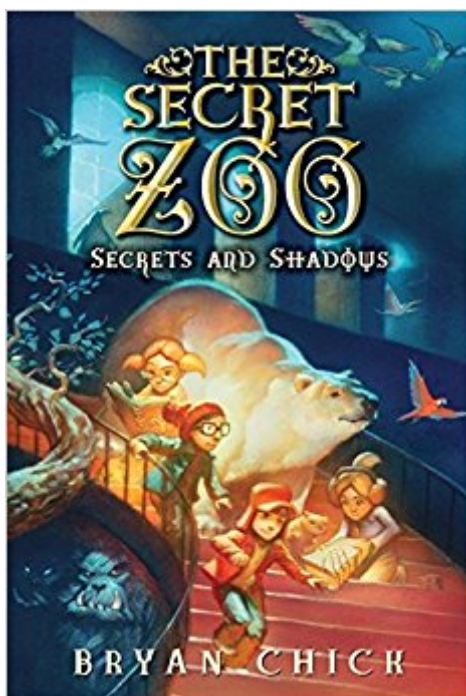

He originally had the idea for the series when he was a nine-year-old and wondered what would happen if zoo exhibits had secret doors that allowed children to go inside . . . and the animals to come outside. This is the 2nd book in Chick's SECRET ZOO series... my 4th grade daughter couldn't get enough of the original book which we got from our local library! I admit to reading it obsessively along with her. We downloaded Secrets & Shadows onto her Kindle so she could have the next one all ready.

It's a great story, and Chick knows how to keep the suspense going with edge of your seat chapters, realistic kid dialogue & characters, and a magical world with many layers and dimensions still to be uncovered and explored. I am recommending to everybody I know with 3rd-5th graders, and already looking forward to reading the 3rd and 4th books in the series!

Kids aged 8-13 all read it and enjoyed it, a mix of both girls and boys (the readers). Asked for the next one in the series so I consider that a win.

Kids can't put them down!!! Yay!

My daughter started the summer prior to third grade really resisting the idea of reading "chapter books". We signed her up for an optional reading incentive program anyway. Once she discovered this series our struggles were over. I read some of the first book of the series to her, and she read the majority of it plus all of this book on her own. She is asking for another "Secret Zoo" book. The teacher said her reading has greatly improved in her first quarter of third grade. Another thing that worked for us...I let her read it on my Kindle. That seems to be extra motivation for her.

This was my second secret zoo book. Although it was on the shorter side I thought it was awesome with lots of action filled parts that I can see in my mind and I look forward to the next books.

After you read this, you will agree with me. This is a five star book. I loved the second book as much as I loved the first book. It had a perfect translation from the first book to the second book. It all made sense. Bryan Chick is a wonderful author. He is so smart and creative. I couldn't even put the book down when I was done reading for the day.
