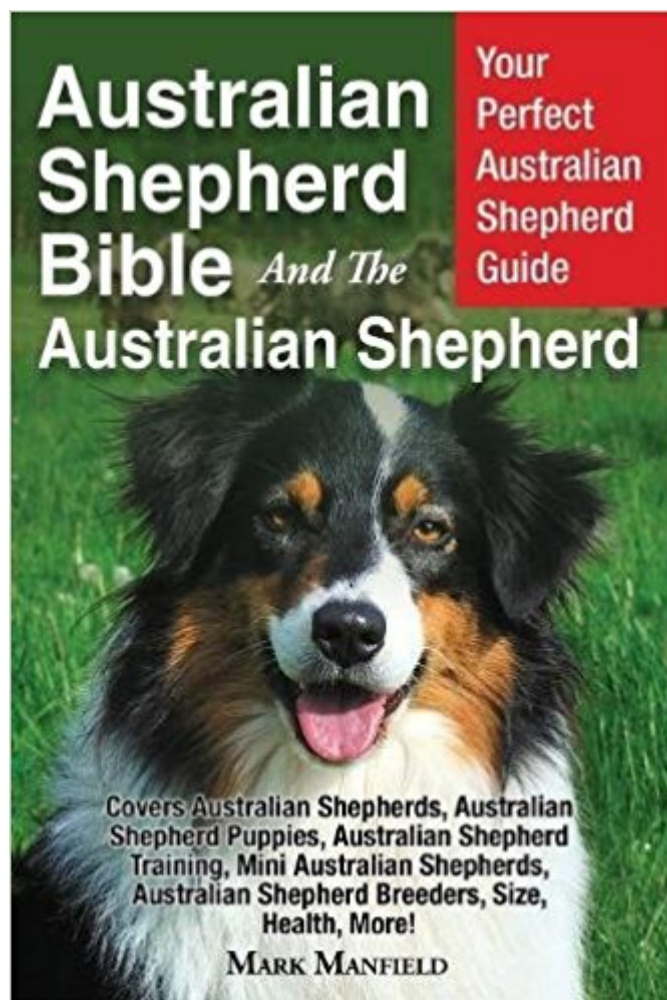

Mark Manfield creates such vivid images of the Australian Shephard that by the end of the book I imagined a specific dog running out back and could just about give it a name: Devoted and bossy, doting and underfoot with an enthusiastic need to be exercised. The main thing to take into consideration regarding Australian Shepherds and the dog breed's suitability to your home is space. Yes. In making statements like this, the author, unlike some, provides a pro-active, realistic view on the responsibility of dog ownership; that the dog is not an object or toy or convenience. The dog's life is shared with the owner. This is the spirit of Mr. Manfield's book and remains a very important concept in itself, a lesson outside the scope of simply selecting a specific breed of dog. His keen insights into important personality traits made me chuckle: "The Australian Shephard will attempt to . . . decipher your personality and whether you can manage to continue on being the alpha dog of your household. Aye. The prospective Australian Shephard owner needs to take heed: You better have your act together. This dog has a work ethic. I liked the comments on selecting a breeder, particularly that the breeder should be invested in his animals as a life work. Health issues are discussed in slightly more detail than other books, some of them complex and breed specific. I had to read more slowly the passages regarding the genetic affliction known as the double merle, an inherited pigmentation trait which is associated with eyesight and hearing problems. This is important information for prospective dog owner as well as one coming to terms with a vet's diagnosis. Discussions of choosing between male and female dogs, purebred or mixed breeds and cost break down, all very specific; often not given enough attention in other books. Space was created for combs and grooming issues, potentially one of those learn-it-the-hard-way topics which is generally skimmed over. His brush section was great, as this breed sheds. Anyone who drives the kids to school in the same car they take Mister Collins to his favorite farmer's field knows hair is an issue. A good book to get training tips in general with a great many specific and comprehensive suggestions made. Crate training is discussed at length with its goal to efficient and clean house behaviors. That section dispelled my personal anxieties about the issue, the main point being, it remains a temporizing method. In that same section, incidentally, he provided a good quote: "Letting him or her out right away if your pet tends to whine will make him or her realize that whining will always get him or her

what he or she wants. A universal principle true for many species of mammals and their offspring (wink wink). In summary, this book is as comprehensive as any book concerning the Australian Shepherd (or other breeds for that matter) while assuming a practical, compassionate and ethical tone. Superb.

This is not only an essential reference for all Australian Shepherd owners, it gives any potential dog owner a vivid idea of what owning this dog would be like. It gives a detail description of the fur, eye color, weight, life-span of this dog. It details breed-specific and general needs for the entire life of the dog: living quarters, the exercise requirements, bathing needs, training, medical issues, and possible genetic issues. These pages also adequately describe the temperament and conveys an idea of whether or not this dog would fit into your particular lifestyle. It also goes over the history of the Australian Shepherd. Basically, whatever possible question you could have concerning this canine, the answer is within this book. It is comprehensive, well-written, engaging, and definitely deserves this five star rating.
