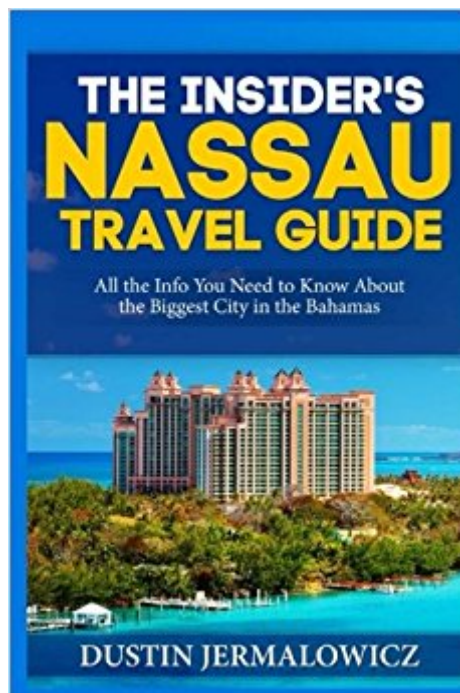

I go to Nassau every few years and am always looking to see what's new there. With the launch of the Baha Mar Resort, there's going to be a lot more stuff opening up, and this guide gives you some good off the beaten path spots to stay. The book's a bit short, but I recommend it for putting on your phone or iPad, as it's easy to navigate to good spots to find spots to eat, relax, or drink at.

The author asks for suggestions so here goes:1) we are staying at Atlantis at the Reef Tower, and this tower is missing from the list for Atlantis Hotel Accommodations.2) maps of where all these places are would help. I have google maps on my iPhone and I was able to punch in the shops, beaches, or restaurants in the search box and it pulled up just fine. Without this, I would be lost with just the book.3) where do you go to take a boat ride? Cruises have these options; not sure how to get to Blue Lagoon if you stay on island.4) more pictures would be cool5) maybe a section on "what not to do" or places to avoidGreat book. We visited last year by cruise but did not like the 4-5 hours we had on the island so we decided to fly in this year for several days.

I never review books, good or bad, but this book is such a rip off (even at such a low price) that I want to warn people away from it. It's 50 pages, and the pages are not numbered so the reader doesn't realize how short it is. The print is enormous, so there's very little information on any page, and many of the pages are more than half white space. Approximately 1/3 of the book is about the Atlantis Resort Guide, which is pictured on the cover. If you're not staying there, the book is of no use. If you ARE staying there, the book contains nothing that you won't find at the concierge desk after you arrive. There are a total of 11 restaurants listed, including budget, medium and luxury. There are 6 stores listed, including "everything" from souvenirs to high-end shops. In the text the writer refers to his book as "tips" and not as a "guide." This book is not worth taking the time to order

and slip out of the container. Truly the worst book on any subject I've ever purchased.

This is a 52 page book with lots of blank space and could have been written by a high school senior. It provides no unique information. Save the money for a rum drink and surf the web.
