

Forbidden by Kimberly Griffiths Little was so captivating that I awoke early in the morning, while my family was still sleeping, so I could finish the last pages of this beautifully haunting tale. The deserts and red canyons of the Middle East create a scenic backdrop for the story of young Jayden and her nomadic family. The ancient setting perfectly matches the lives and actions of the realistic, yet enthralling characters. The account tells of a time and place when a man's honor was in his word and when the bonds between friends and family trumped all else. By the time innocent Jayden performs the ritualistic betrothal dance, the lives of her father's kin had long been intertwined with the family of her future husband. But her fate was not sealed until the death of the future prince left her in line to marry the next tribal heir. Though young women in her clan envy her future marriage, Jayden sees the truth about strong and willful Horeb, and wants nothing to do with him. When tragedy leaves her alone in the desert, Jayden comes upon an injured stranger, mysterious and handsome Kadesh. His secrets are matched only by his compassion for the sorrowful girl who

nurses him back to health, and in so doing captures his heart. The story of Jayden's journey is a moving tale of family, honor, pride, selflessness, heart-wrenching deception and stirring love. It will keep you turning pages and wanting for more!

As a blogger it has become rarer and rarer over the years for me to preorder a book. But there have been a dearth of ancient civ novels in my life this past decade and my gut told me that *FORBIDDEN* was going to be a book I would love. I mean, it's not every day you're swept away to Old Testament times and taken on an epic adventure with a young woman protagonist. Jayden suffers so much tragedy! I was literally curled up at the opposite end of the couch from my husband and he looked over at me and asked what was wrong because I had tears on my face. When I explained what had just happened to Jayden, what had happened leading up to what had set me off... he wasn't at all surprised it had moved me and I was only about a quarter of the way into it! But Jayden fights and fights and fights for herself, for her family, for what she believes in. Kadesh is an interesting hero, though I'm not certain he is a particularly accurate depiction of what a young man of the time would be like. He's a little too romantic and doesn't treat Jayden like the property of another man. *FORBIDDEN* is set in a time when her father or her betrothed was the norm of the era but I found it forgivable because it makes for a wonderful story. If ever I was to claim a book boyfriend for myself I think I would consider Kadesh worthy of the title. The culture and way of life of the time *FORBIDDEN* is set in is extremely fascinating and I very much wanted to know even more. *FORBIDDEN* is the kind of story that you sit down to consume only to find that it has consumed you. Though I had read about 15% of it previously, the day I sat down with it again I read the whole thing in one sitting which is unheard of for me. I'm so glad I made this my first read of the new year because it was absolutely amazing. I loved it so much I want to make everyone read it. Alas, since I cannot, please consider giving it a read. It is intensely romantic, heart-wrenchingly sad, laced with hope, and will leave you dying for the release of the next book in the trilogy, *BANISHED*.

I've been looking forward to reading this book for a long time, and I was thrilled that it lived up to all my hopes for it. *FORBIDDEN* is a beautifully written story that will transport you back to the world of an ancient people who scraped out a harsh yet stunning life in Ancient Arabia. The writing is lyrical, the description fabulous, and the plots many twists and turns kept surprising me at every point. Just when I thought I knew where it was going, something changed and the thrill ride started all over again. I've written four novels set in Ancient Arabia, and Little's research was more than impressive, and more importantly it never got in the way of the story--instead the research created the

fascinating framework of lives past. Rarely do I look forward to a sequel, but this one, I might have to beg an ARC from the author.
