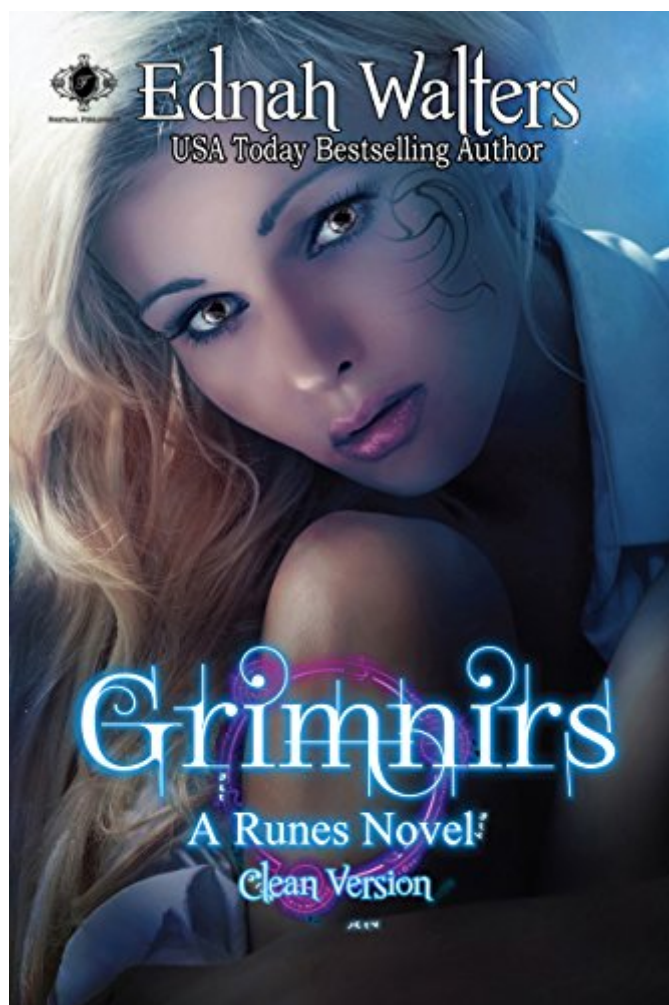


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Grimnirs: Clean Version (Runes Series Book 3)

I enjoyed this book and the talents of this author. The characters are memorable, likable, and one is truly funny with his arrogance. The only thing that disappointed me, is I'm wanting the story that started in book one, that rolled over into book 2, to also roll into book 3 and so on. Now maybe the author picks up the story again in a later book, but that's such a huge risk that we keep reading that far down the line. This book has a whole new threat taking place. I did like the twist at the beginning and how it all played out. I just prefer to have the story continue on from book to book, so when you get to the end everything is answered and complete. Don't know if that will happen in this series or if each book is a whole new issue

In book 3 we get a point of view from Cora, Raine's best friend. This book is pretty graphic, so I would limit the age group as to how young should read it. I read the original version, but there is also a clean version available as well. For the older readers, I think it is a great book, as you meet new characters and get to know Cora's run of events as to what happens, and meet a whole different group of people (Griminirs). In this book we get introduced to Echo, who becomes a main character in the rest of the series. He helps Cora get through so many issues she was having when she was at PMI and she eventually makes up with Raine, although their relationship never goes back to how it was before. The main aspect that bothers me in the books is how close Raine, Cora, and Eirik were, but the moment they meet someone else, it's like their friendship is put on the back burner. They do not hardly see each other, and rarely get time without the significant other there as well. It seems like a slightly unhealthy relationship on both sides.

I read; especially when it comes to series books. I didn't think that EW's 'Runes' or 'Immortals' could be topped, but I was wayyyy wrong!! Her friends didn't figure it out until it was too late. Unfortunately that's not her only problem. Though she convinced the shrink to let her go, she actually still CAN see ghosts everywhere she goes. Now she must dodge them while trying not to get locked back into the crazy house! She's doing her best when a final complication is thrown her way. The sexiest man she's ever met is convinced they're in a relationship. She tries to tell him someone had been impersonating her, but he won't believe her. Will she be able to get rid of him? Or will she even want to? The chemistry is Hot between Cora and Echo and the ride Cora must go on is crazy! You will love this book!
