

Worship For The Whole People Of God: Vital Worship For The 21st Century



Synopsis

This new book on worship by renowned hymn writer and professor Ruth C. Duck provides theological foundations for worship and explores the variety of ways Christians have adapted worship to various cultures to help them live faithfully and to communicate the Gospel to others. The author celebrates the many languages and cultural settings in which the Gospel has been, and is, preached, sung, and prayed. The goal of this volume is to support good pastoral and congregational reflection on what worship is and does. Consequently, Duck discusses many different forms of worship from several cultures (African-American, Asian, Euro-American) and offers advice on how to read a congregation and define its culture in order to plan culturally appropriate worship. Although the book does not offer prescriptive formulas or advise a single pattern of worship, it includes many practical suggestions for preparing and leading worship, including diverse ministries of music, movement, and visual arts that are becoming more popular today. From worship's theological underpinnings the book turns to worship leadership, forms of prayer, preaching, the sacraments, ordination, and various other liturgies. Because of its emphasis on vital and Spirit-led worship, this comprehensive book on Christian worship will be used in years to come not only as a core textbook for seminarians and ministry students from a variety of cultures and traditions, but also as a resource for local church pastors and laity who are dedicated to the enlivening of Christian worship.

Ruth C. Duck is Professor of Worship at Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary in Evanston, Illinois. A prolific hymn writer, she is the author of *Praising God: The Trinity in Christian Worship*,

published by Westminster John Knox Press.

An honest title for this book would be "Worship Tactics of Western Mainline Denominations in the U.S. and sometimes Canada with Notes on Historical Practices and Some of the Practices of Non-Mainline Christians." This is the kind of title old books had, but publishers like to sell books so they give them titles they think will inspire people. This book is thorough, sometimes overly so, but it is far, far too tactical. It contains too little theological grounding for various practices and follows a pattern of "Christians of the past did this, this study says this, mainline churches do this, but some Pentecostal or African American or Native American churches sometimes do this." Most of the useful advice in this book could have been condensed into an essay called "How to Be Aware of People on the Margins When Planning a Worship Service." People who are not theologically progressive will also find a lot in this book that they will disagree with. That in and of itself might not be an issue, but Duck does not seem to be aware that her theological positions are not accepted by many Christians. She gives little to no reason for why she thinks what she thinks. This great lack of the "why" behind the content in this book is a huge flaw that I found incredibly frustrating. The outcomes of following the advice in this book are also doubtful. I attended one United Methodist service where the printed program was multiple pages and the liturgy so complicated that I had no idea what I was supposed to have taken away with me when I left. After reading this book I could see Duck's fingerprints all over that service. Whether the people planning that service had read her book or not I don't know, but both Duck and that person share the same dizzying inability to simplify and focus. Although many evangelical churches in the U.S. and perhaps Canada have lost touch with deeper liturgical traditions from the historic church, and need to rediscover some of them, this book is not the way forward. It holds too tightly to the worship forms of the 1950's and 60's, missing a huge opportunity to tie worship deeply to both Scripture and tradition while keeping the door open for contemporary expressions of liturgy. I cannot recommend this book.

If you are moved by worship and want to gain a deeper understanding of liturgy, this is a valuable addition to your library.
