From there he pastored churches in California, Kentucky, and South Carolina, before moving to Sydney Australia for a brief period, preaching and teaching. In 1934, at 48 years old, he returned to his native England. He took permanent residence in Lewis, Scotland, in 1940, remaining there 12 years until his death at age 66 in 1952.

I wanted a solid commentary on the miracles of Elisha because you never hear anyone speak on him. It's all about Elijah. I really like the way this author cross-references scripture. I would like to learn to do the same. Most of my study has been inductive, but Pink's approach offers much more that can be life-changing.

The best book on the Life and Ministry of Elisha that I've ever read. If anyone plans to preach, teach, or study the great double-filled, bald-headed Prophet, this volume needs to be in his or her library. Also the Book is so neatly arranged, so logical. Not only informative, but enjoyable as well!

Arthur Pink is always so insightful in his commentary. This one follows his commentary on Elijah (one of his best) He discourses (for want of a better explanation) on various events in Elisha's life, hence the title being "gleanings". One thing i do like about Pink is that he is able to present his commentary in a well-written, logical manner but make it relevant. He isn't talking about current

events to explain (those are useful but can become dated quickly and irrelevant to the next generation. Ironside sometimes gets this way) applications, but sticks very close to Scripture to explain Scripture which is very necessary for now when people have had dumbed down Bible Studies without "meat" in them and miss the actual meaning behind what is there. This is a lot of "meat" for a believer and takes a while to get through because thinking about what he is saying takes time.

This is a wonderful commentary on the story and miracles of Elisha. It gives us insight into the meaning and application of each story. We can see how this ancient prophet has insight for us today!
