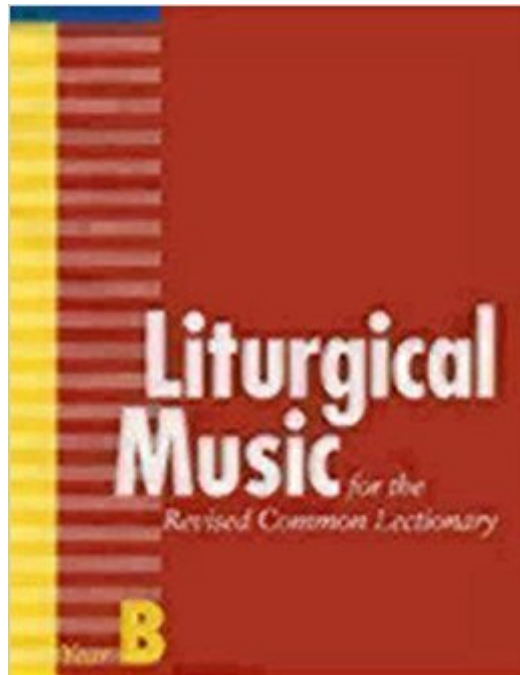

Liturgical Music For The Revised Common Lectionary, Year B



Synopsis

A planning guide for church musicians and clergy for selecting hymns, songs, and anthems, for the three-year liturgical cycle following the Revised Common Lectionary. Â Â Hymns and songs keyed to the appropriate liturgical occasion for Sundays in the Revised Common Lectionary for the three-year cycle. This is the first book of the three-book series (Years A, B, and C) Includes selections from The Hymnal 1982, Lift Every Voice and Sing, Wonder, Love, and Praise, Voices Found, and My Heart Sings Out. Tunes are cross referenced to choir and instrumental descant resources from Church Publishing. Each selection is coded for its appropriate use at the entrance, before the Gospel, at the offering of gifts, communion, or at the end of liturgy. Selections are listed by their relationship to the texts appointed for the day with indications which texts are direct quotes or paraphrases of the appointed scripture. First lines of hymns and songs include their page number and book location.

He has published a psalter for the RCL and numerous liturgical planning materials for the Lutheran church (ELCA).

This book is part of a three part series assisting Episcopal priests, deacons, and musicians in

selecting appropriate hymns for a given Sunday, such as "Proper 10." It is a good resource,. My only suggestion is to pay the extra money for a hard copy. This is the kind of book where one has to flip pages in order to go back and forth between Sundays when planning out a month or more worship services. I purchased this in the Kindle version and found that to be very distracting. Its suggestions would be useful for any denomination (i.e. Lutheran, Catholic) that uses the liturgical lectionary series for their Gospel, psalms, and other Bible lessons.

What I needed.

As a new Director of Adult Music this book has been extremely helpful in sorting out anthems for the next several weeks. I can check titles against my music library and use the readings of the day and/or the psalm to match it to something I have available. With this book I have already planned my choirs anthems for the next 6 weeks. I would highly recommend this for any choral director -whether new or established - involved with a church using the Revised Common Lectionary. My plan is to have Year(s) A and C at my fingertips very soon.
