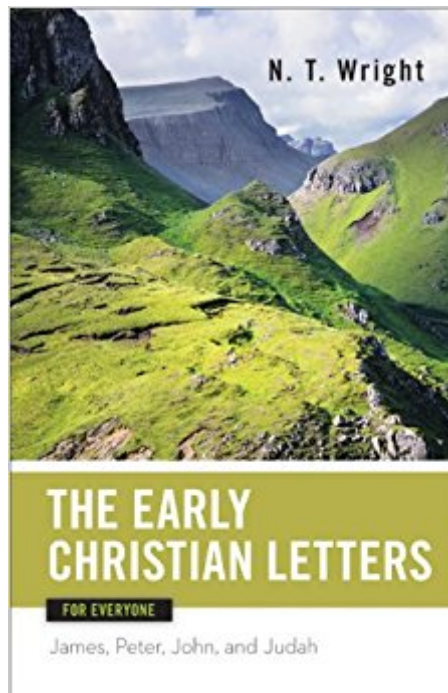




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Synopsis

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N. T. Wright is the Chair in New Testament and Early Christianity at the University of St. Andrews in Scotland. He is the former Bishop of Durham in the Church of England and is a prolific author and

noted New Testament scholar. His books include Scripture and the Authority of God, Surprised by Hope, Simply Christian, and Evil and the Justice of God.

I love N.T. Wright's "for Everyone" studies, and this was another great one (we did the Letters of John, and we may do James next, as it is included in this commentary guide). In the study guide that can be used along with this book, Wright provides really thought-provoking questions that get some great conversation and discussion going.
