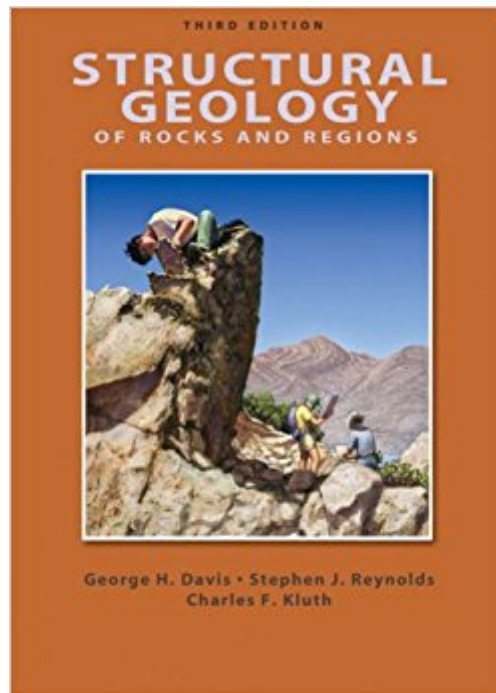




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Structural Geology Of Rocks And Regions, 3rd Edition

George Davis has thoughtfully put together a wonderful textbook based on his years of experience. Important concepts include mapping techniques, in the field, stereonet; as well as many other fundamental concepts to the field of structural geology. This book is intended for an undergraduate course and sometimes utilizes comical approaches to express Davis's enthusiasm applied to real world situations (such as the pepperoni pizza) conveying important concepts to the reader in an easy to understand format.

Structural geology is pretty dry. This textbook isn't very exciting. Note the word textbook. Davis is

actually pretty hilarious in examples he uses. He's also a madly talented structural geologist.
