

reviewed the areas that i had a little difficulty in and thanks to this book i mastered them, scored in the top 3 percent.

This book definitely helped give me a feel for the ASVAB AFQT and it has some great information. I

feel confident going into the test now. It was however very vague sometimes when it came to working with big numbers. I was kinda lost when I had figure out $127,750/365$ or find the square root of 49,513.25 in the practice tests. There were also a few typos that I ran across. You might want to fix these before getting into the book, or they could be potentially confusing. They may have been fixed in later prints of the book, but these are the mistakes I found in mine: Pg 126: The very last thing on the page should be 10:02, not 6:02. Pg 240: The equation on the next to last line should be " $384/9 = 42.66$ ", not " $384/3 = 42.66$ ". Pg 248: The correct answer to question 10 corresponds to C, not B. There's one or two more before page 126, but I didn't write them down. Good luck.

This book describes why getting a good score on the ASVAB/AFQT tests are important in getting the type of job you will qualify for in the military. I think it is a good primer but you begin to realize that you should have studied harder in school when you start to take the practice exams. It's hard to be good at math and reading without earlier preparation although this will help.

My boyfriend used this to study for the Military Entrance exam and it came out ok. Most of the things he studied from this book did not come out at all not even close. So I will not recommend this book to everyone. If I were you, buy the latest version. It will help you better than this one.

You're either considering buying this book to improve your current (decent) score, or you just can't get a passing score. **DON'T BUY THIS BOOK IF YOUR SCORE IS ALREADY GOOD.** It will not help. I had previously scored a 75 on my ASVAB a few years ago when I was in high school. Since it's been a few years since I've been in high school I figured I would buy this book to "freshen up" my knowledge. I also thought that maybe it would give me a few pointers that I could use to study. Sadly it did not. Literally **EVERYTHING** in this book was just common sense, for me at least. But I can't really knock it because it could be beneficial for others.

This book is worth every penny! Both of Rod Powers "for Dummies" books have been purchased and we continue to use them still, as my son plans on entering the Canadian army in September. I have not found anything this side of the border that compares in quality of study material or how it's presented. Although the Canadian test is different, I would highly recommend both to anyone wanting to prepare for either the American AFQT, or the Canadian CFAT. Can't go wrong!

I purchased this book for my daughter because the recruiters recommended it. She has had this

book for a good two months now and her scores on the practice test improved each time she took the test. I gave this 4 stars because my daughter said the science stuff on the test wasn't in this book. My daughter barely made it through High School and still this book improved her scores. So with that being said, I recommend this book.
