

The cartoon animals are hilarious ; Before you know it, you will know all sorts of pertinent facts about every President including his personal statistics, personal facts, his accomplishments and the poetry to introduce each one is amazing, i.e.: "As animal lovers, The Clevelands accrued, so many pets, Their house was a zoo! Foxhounds and dachshunds, Ran all around, Chasing wild rabbits all over the grounds."

Combines history and pets ÅfÃ¢Â ÄÃ œ with a little poetry thrown in. Provides the opportunity for students to choose a president to learn a little more about (they are more interesting once kids know they had pets) and write a poem about their own pets or the pet they would want to live with them in the White House when they become president. Great tool.

This is a fun book, with not only information about the animals at the White House, but a few interesting facts thrown in as well. My son and I are studying the presidents this summer. To make the study fun, we are learning about the president's pets, their children and what they liked to eat.
