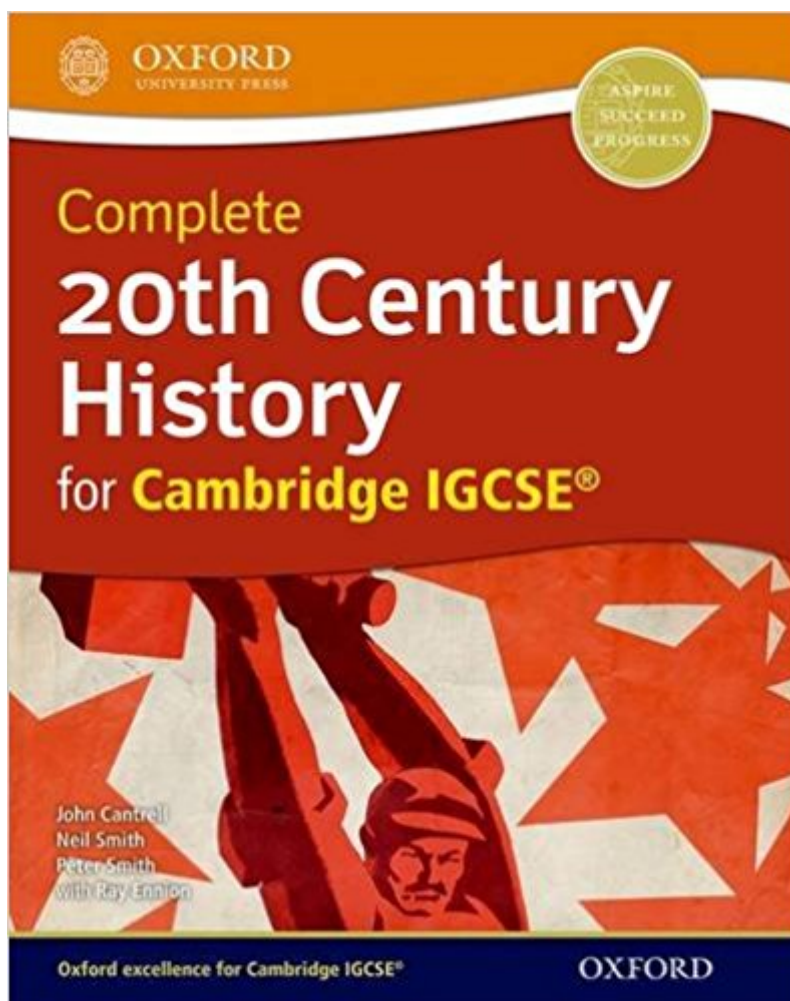

This is a great book which examines historical events from various angles and perspectives and leaves its reader with a wealth of knowledge upon which to base their opinions. I highly recommend it!

The Discussion and Task questions are very similar to the kinds of questions on the IGCSE exam, and they relate to an excellent variety of relevant primary sources. These components of the book are very helpful in preparation for the History exam. However, I cannot get over the fact that the text is loaded with grammatical errors and awkward language:p. 159 "The First World War was fought across many different countries, and two trenches were the same."p. 169 "Within the Royal Navy, and the public at large, there remained a desire to achieve the type of decisive major victory which would rank with previous naval victories such as this experience occurred on 31 May 1916."p. 173 "Why was the convoy system more effective than other method of tackling the U-boat threat?"...and I've only read one chapter... Is there not a team of editors whose job it is to fix these mistakes? How is this even possible in a TEXTBOOK endorsed by CAMBRIDGE?
