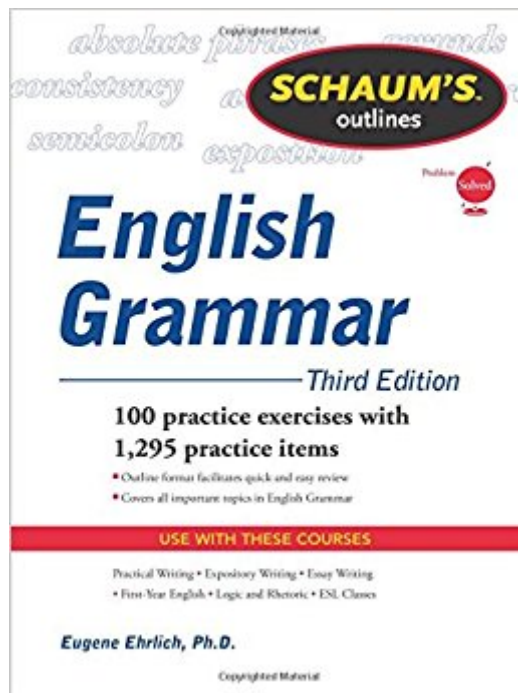

Several years ago I obtained a Ph.D. in chemical engineering and have now decided to brush up on my grammar skills. The best way to use this book is to have a main book that describes all of the concepts. My remedial English class in college used the grammar book titled "The Writer's Workplace." Now go to the schaum's book and work the corresponding problems. Do five problems in a section then check the answers in the back of the book. If you answered any of the problems incorrectly, do your best to figure out why you answered them incorrectly. Continue this procedure for the entire book. I personally own over 100 schaum's titles. In my opinion, there is no such thing as too many schaum's outlines titles.
