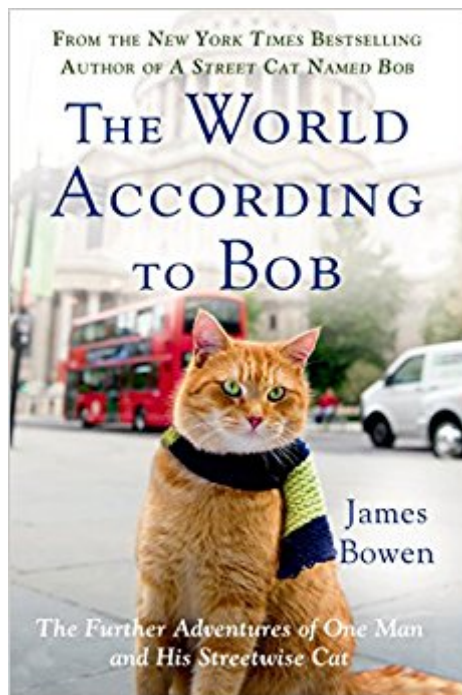

This is a book which can be read, understood and sympathised with from teenagers to grandparents and is never less than inspirational. A lesson to those who refuse to believe in the importance of animals (any animal) to human beings from an entirely psychological and emotional point of view. Their healing gifts have been proved again and again in hospitals, institutions and even prisons - I once saw an amazing film, a true story, where some six dogs were introduced into a women's prison harbouring some of the worst kind of criminals who were each given a dog to train as a seeing-eye dog. The results were extraordinary, the women's characters and emotional reactions changed radically and their affection for their trainees made their eventual and inevitable separation very difficult....the idea being, however, that they would then receive another dog to train! The emotional and beneficial impact of pets of any kind or size on human beings is incalculable and is unfortunately being proved again and again as we 'learn' to accept our fellow creatures as company and not only to eat!
