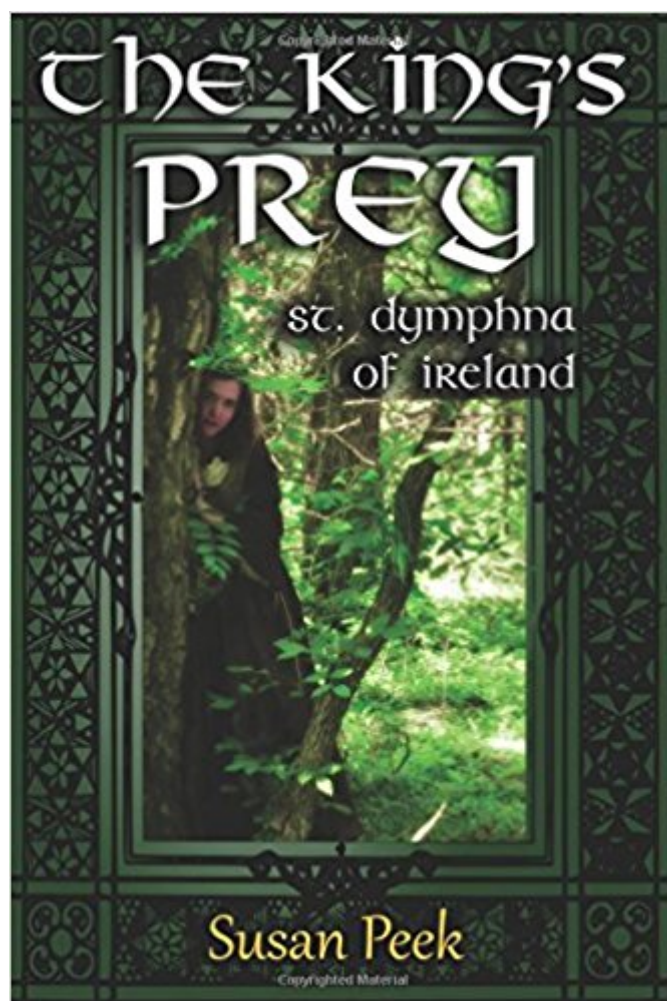


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The King's Prey: Saint Dymphna Of Ireland (God's Forgotten Friends)
