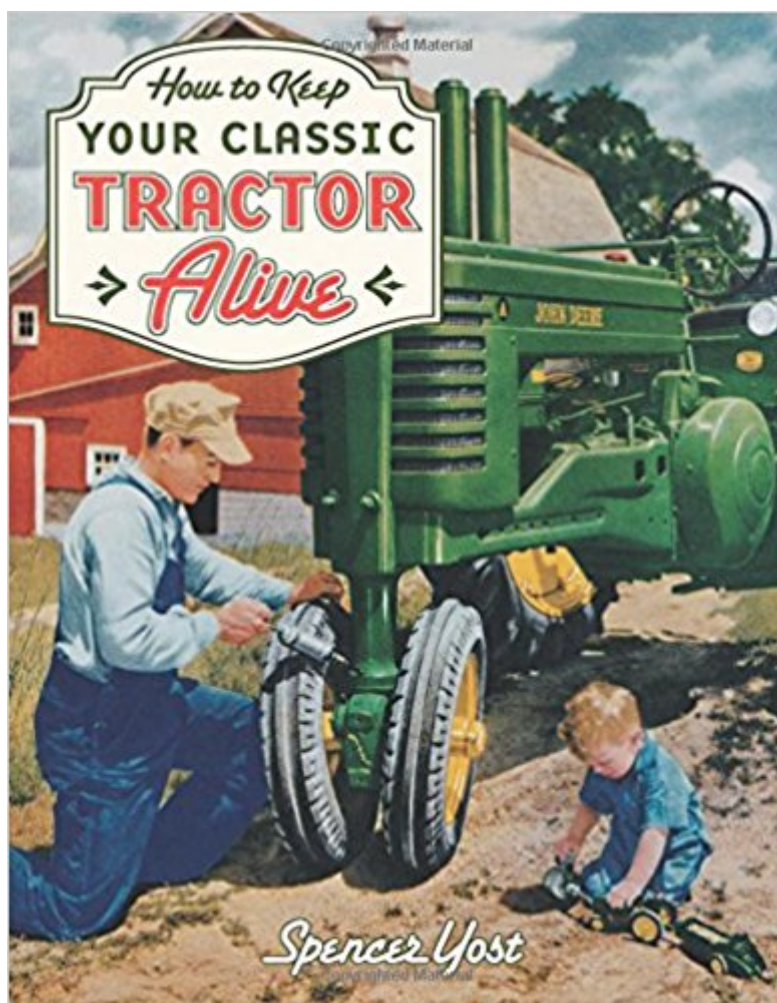

The author starts with a consideration of choice in buying a used tractor, gives a brief tour of different companies and machines, and discusses operation, safety, maintenance, and overhauling.
