

This text is printed on demand at 's distribution facility. The copy I recently purchased was of the absolute WORST quality. It appears as if has taken to printing a bad PDF and passing it off as a good edition worthy of the asking price. Specifically, the printed text is pixelated and difficult to read, and hardly worthy of the asking price. One would do better to download a freely available copy on the Internet and print it themselves: certainly it could be of no worse quality than what delivers. An otherwise excellent edition of an essential text in the history of political thought should not be purchased via Prime.

The text itself is of course outstanding and a must-read for anyone interested in human political behavior, and is especially relevant today. But the quality of the printing is poor. The text is pixelated and while readable, not the most comfortable, especially for such small font. The price was right, however.
