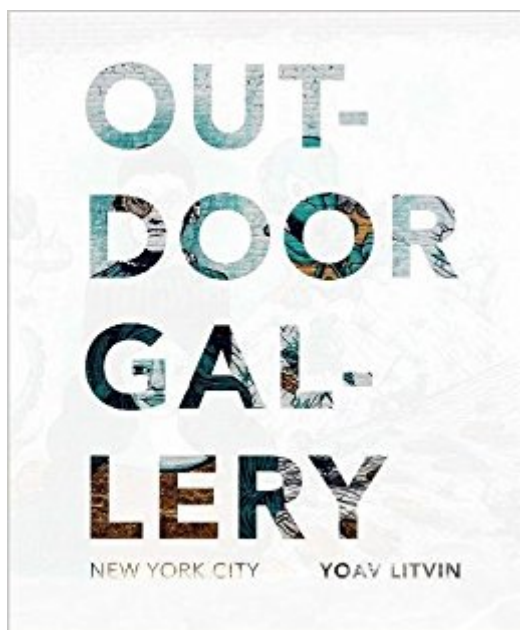

Synopsis

Outdoor Gallery - New York City documents the vibrancy of the diverse contemporary street art environment of New York City. The book predominantly collects the work of New York based artists, running the gamut from old school graffiti writers such as COPE2, to contemporary street artists such as HELLBENT, EKG, ASVP, CERN and GAIA. Their work is showcased alongside that of some international fellow travelers including NICK WALKER, THE YOK, SHERYO and KRAM. The book features hundreds of pieces of art by 46 different artists. The well-photographed works are accompanied by the artists musings on New York, street art and their own work and processes. This work is non-permanent and necessarily current and relevant. In Outdoor Gallery New York resident and author Yoav Litvin successfully documents the zeitgeist. I own quite a few books on street art but this beautifully presented book is by far my favourite. The photos are really wonderful, but for me what makes this stand out is that we hear from the artists in their own words. Their views on street art in general, on their own art, on NYC, on the future and on their process, not too many books of a similar vein do that! I loved reading about some of my favourite artists, and also being introduced to new ones I hadn't heard of. Nice job!

This is a gorgeous book detailing a very important subculture of the art world whose art is here one day and very possibly gone the next. It presents a uniform method of interviewing the artists and may one day be a very important source book for this genre of art.
