The guide is straightforward, with everything one needs to know to cruise the Virgin Islands. For the price it is a real bargain. Plus, it is in color and without ads on top of ads.

As a former charter boat captain, I have lots of experience in the area. All of my secret spots remain

unrevealed. That is the shortcoming. The British Virgin Islands still have secluded anchorage. The book does tell the story of sailing the waters and opens one's imagination. A challenge for charterers is wind direction. When the breeze fills in from the NE a large number of anchorage are untenable. Three places are perfect all the time, The Bight, Sopers Hole, and North Sound. Anegada is not to be missed. Remember: always start a conversation with "good morning" or the appropriate time of day. Enjoy the Islands.

Not a cruising guide. Not helpful at all with coming into anchorages or sailing in the islands.
